Workshop on “**Bioinformatics Algorithms**” will be held as part of the *International Joint Conference on Bioinformatics, Systems Biology and Intelligent Computing (IJCBS'09)*, which will take place in *Shanghai, China on August 3rd - 6th, 2009*. You are invited to submit papers to this workshop with unpublished work on bioinformatics algorithms.

Original research papers are solicited in **all aspects of algorithms in bioinformatics**, including, but not limited to: algorithms for *sequence alignment and assembly, genetics and genomics sequence analysis, bio-ontology and data mining, identification and classification of genes, sequence search and alignment, protein structure prediction and molecular simulation, molecular evolution and phylogeny, functional genomics, proteomics, pathways, gene networks, proteomics, functional genomics, drug discovery and design, gene expression analysis, bio-data visualization, modeling and simulation of bio-sets, biomarkers of toxicity, bio-imaging, signaling and computation*. In addition, *high-performance computing approaches* to implementing and testing algorithms for computationally hard problems in bioinformatics, and *methods, software, and dataset repositories* for development and testing of bioinformatics algorithms are also welcome.
